

Create A Country Schedule

I. Pencil Stage Day 1

1. Using a **ruler**, draw the lines of latitude and longitude for your map. Remember, this is a drawing of your country, not the world. Just show the lines of latitude and longitude that affect your country.
2. Draw the shape of your country onto the Mercator Projection you have drawn.
3. In the top right hand corner, draw the cardinal directions using a compass rose.
4. Create a scale for your map. Insert it at the bottom right side of your poster.

II Pencil Stage Day 2

1. Make a 1st key for the following: desert, mountains, river, lake, oceans, cities, capital, major road or highway, railroad, bridge.
2. Draw a mountain range at the top of your country (leave a gap somewhere in the range).
3. Make a river flow through the mountain range.
4. Label each of the above.

III. Pencil Stage Day 3

1. Draw two cities, making one a port
 - Create two rivers to connect to the first river
 - Connect the two cities by railway
2. Draw a lake
3. Insert a desert on your map.
4. Make the capital city
 - Draw a road connecting the capital to two other cities.
5. Name and Label all the above.

IV. Pencil Day 4

1. Make a 2nd key showing elevation by color in the bottom left corner.
2. Insert an isthmus anywhere within your country.
3. Make sure the cartographer of your country is written across the bottom of your map.
